JOHN WESLEY AND THE TEACHING MINISTRY

During his long career, John Wesley wrote much about educational theory and was involved in a variety of educational endeavors. He and his followers established numerous day- and boarding schools. Wesley must be credited with substantial contributions to English education in general and with helping to foster the later development of universal education in the nation. He understood the potential for education to function as an instrument of social reform and sought to use it for the benefit of the disadvantaged socioeconomic classes.
