Making tea: the recipe is posted on the pantry door in the Canteen. Tea leaves, sugar and milk provided. Do come one Sunday earlier to find out details and rudiments of preparing the refreshments. For the Myanmarese who come for English class at 4.30pm on Sundays we need packed food and bottled mineral water. There are between 10 and 15 of them.

We need English teachers on Sundays to teach Nepali (2.45-4.30pm) and Myanmarese (4.30-6pm) migrant workers. Numbers are not regular because of their working hours, so patience and flexibility are needed.

c. Doctors and Nurses/Medical and Health Care Ministry

There are plans for an in-house medical and health care ministry for migrant workers, Orang Asli, etc. We would welcome doctors, nurses and other volunteers to come and help set up and serve in this ministry.

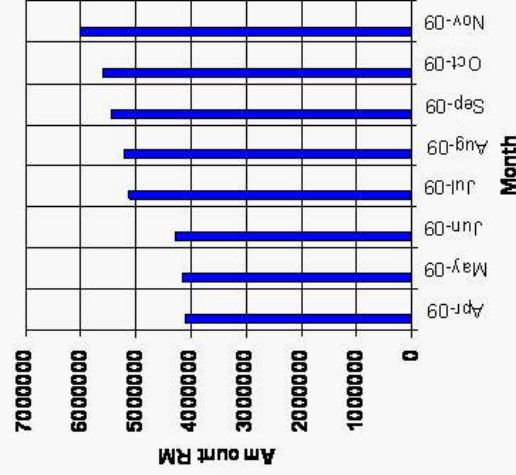
