9. LEGACY TREE PROJECT UPDATE

a. Big Walk

About 200 people took part in the walk on 24 April. We would like to thank the organizing committee for a well organized event.

Collections can be paid at the counters set up in the parish hall after the services today and on 9 May 2010. Thereafter, please make your payments at the church office by 15 May.

b. Tender Award

The tender for Package 1 has been awarded to Rata (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd. This was approved by the LCEC on 22 April 2010. It includes earthworks, foundation and the basement.

The Youth Centre is expected to be demolished around mid-May and the site will be cordoned off if everything goes smoothly and subject to JKR approval. Please pray for things to go according to schedule.

c. Collection of Funds

As at 27 April about RM6.9 million has been raised. A further RM1.8 million has been pledged. This adds up to approximately RM8.7 million. About RM5.5 million more needs to be raised. Assuming this is shared among 1,000 members, each member would need to raise RM5,500 by November 2011.

The entire project cost of RM14.25 million, if shared among 1,400 members, would come to about RM10,000 per head.

10. APPEAL FOR DONATION OF USED ITEMS

11. MAY POOR AND NEEDY OFFERING FOR KENOSIS HOME

All collections from the poor and needy offering for the month of May will be contributed to Kenosis Home, a Christian rehabilitation home for drug addicts. Kenosis Home is located at Jalan Jugra, off Jalan Kelang Lama. Residents of the Home help out regularly to prepare food and drinks for our weekly street ministry. The boys also help to set up and to dismantle the tents where we conduct worship and serve food to the street people. Please give generously to support their ministry.

A cheque for the amount of RM7,494.60 being the collection from the poor and needy offering in the month of March was handed over to Agathians Shelter on 22 April 2010. The Agathians Shelter is a non-government organisation looking after the needs of boys particularly orphans, street children and abused children between the age of 4 and 18 years old. 50% of the residents are Hindus, 30% Christians and 20% Buddhists. Agathians Shelter appreciates contribution of church members.

12. THE KAIROS CONDENSED WORLD MISSIONS COURSE (organized by World Outreach Malaysia) will be held in **Wesley Methodist Church Kuala Lumpur** from **30 May 2010 until 20 June 2010**. The 8-module course, held over four week-ends, provides an excellent introduction to world missions for all church members, and is a pre-requisite for those intending to participate in the short-term missions projects organized by our Missions Committee. 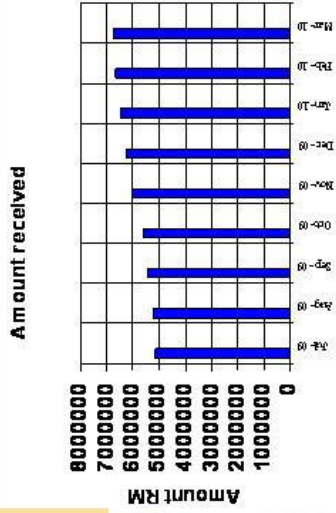

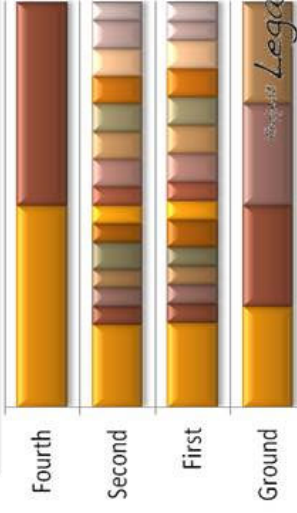
