5. CHRISTIAN SOCIAL CONCERNS COMMITTEE

A cheque of RM7,286.30 was handed to Pastor Richard Lee from Kenosis Home last week. This amount was collected from the May offering for the poor and needy. Kenosis Home is a Christian drug rehabilitation center located along Jalan Jugra, off Jalan Kelang Lama and works closely with the weekly Street Ministry in the preparation of food and drinks and the putting up and dismantling of the canopy. The Home also renders transportation service and able to help out in simple masonry and painting jobs for a fee.

The July collection for the poor and needy will be contributed to Bethany Home in Simpang Empat, Teluk Intan – a Christian center and home for epileptic and autistic children and adults.

The Blood Donation Campaign held on Sunday, June 6 in the Parish Hall collected 19 pints of blood from church members and friends. Some had to be turned away as they were not feeling well. 5 persons also pledged to donate their organs. We are grateful for the support of all blood and organ donors. The next Campaign will be held on Sunday, December 5. Watch out for more details.

As part of our efforts in caring for our Father's world, the Christian Social Concerns Committee wish to make **an appeal** to all parishes, small groups and organizations which use the canteen to sell food to **refrain** from using throwaways like plastic spoons or chopsticks and Styrofoam boxes to contain food. The church has enough reusable bowls, plates, forks, spoons and chopsticks for the food sale each week. We even have the services of cleaners to help in the washing up of these utensils. Let us do our part by preserving our earth for the future of our children.

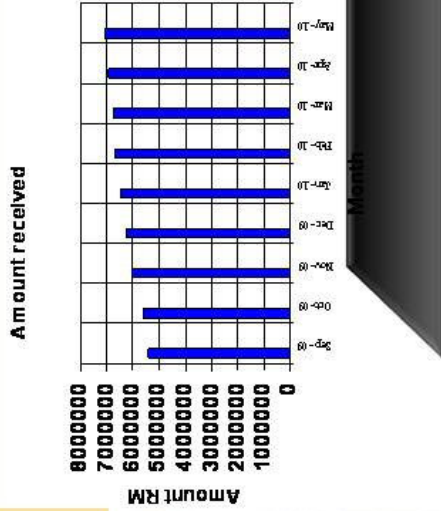

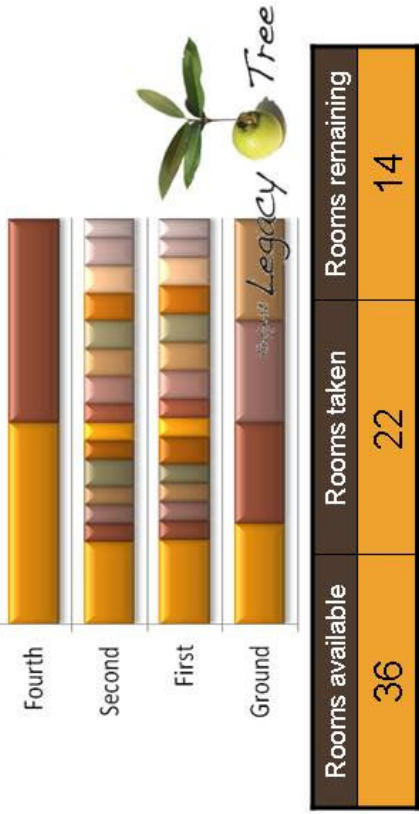
