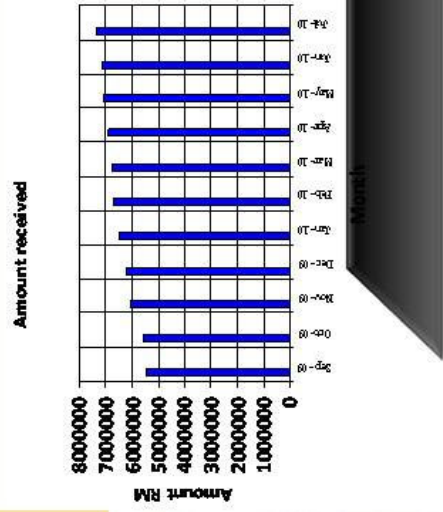

The Legacy Tree Project Donation of Rooms

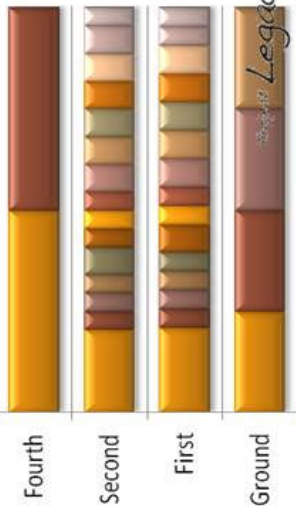
