## **10. METHODIST MEN'S PROFESSIONAL PUBLIC HEALTH TALK**

**Guest Speaker:** Dr Raymond Tan Suan-Kuo FRCS (Glasgow,UK), Consultant ENT Surgeon (Ear, Nose & throat) and Snoring Specialist

**Topic:** Killer Snores:- Snoring and Obstructive Sleep Apnea(OSA)

Snoring is often laughed at and taken very lightly. However, it regularly hides a life-threatening disease called OSA(Obstructive Sleep Apnea). OSA sufferers repeatedly choke and gasp for breath accompanied by multiple episodes of breathing stoppages throughout their sleep. These patients invariably end up with high blood pressure and quite a few of them may also end up with heart disease and strokes because of OSA. This will be an interesting and informative talk detailing how to diagnose and treat this condition.

Dr Raymond Tan is our Methodist Men's President and is active in our church's various medical mission work. He is practicing in Kuala Lumpur with several private medical centers as a Consultant ENT Surgeon and Snoring Specialist. 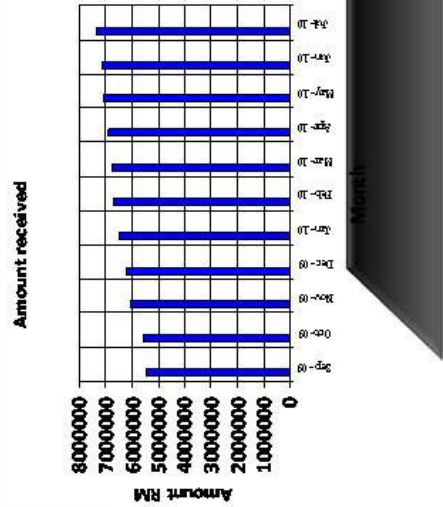

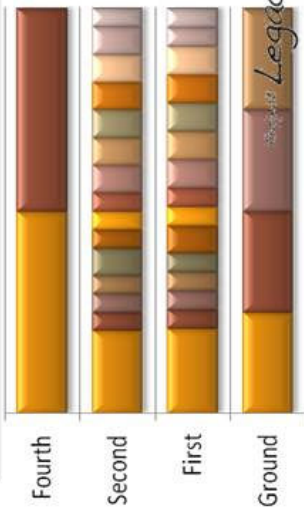
