**1. ASIAN BEACON (August-September 2010)** is now available at RM5 per copy at the Church office. Back issues are also available at RM2.50 per copy.

### **2. WESLEY HOME UPDATE**

Wesley Outreach Society is pleased to announce that the Development Order for the demolition and reconstruction of Wesley Home located at No.8 Jalan Meru, Off Jalan Kelang Lama, Kuala Lumpur was received last month. The tender for the project was called and the contract has been awarded to Puncak Semerah Sdn Bhd at the tender price of RM890,000.00. Work commenced on 2 August 2010 and will be completed in 32 weeks. Handover of the building is expected on 13 March 2011.

The Society hopes to replace the current 15-year-old van used to transport the residents as it breaks down frequently and is beyond economic maintenance. We want to replace it with a Chinese-made van to be fitted with a wheelchair lift. The new van is fitted with a Japanese engine and has a warranty of 3 years.

Cost of van with wheelchair lift: RM90,000.00  
Less trade-in of present van : 10,000.00  
Amount needed for new van : RM80,000.00

We wish to appeal to members and friends to help us meet the cost of purchasing this new van. Your contributions and cheques in support of the new van can be made in favor of WESLEY OUTREACH SOCIETY, KL & SELANGOR and sent to No. 2, Jalan Wesley, 50150 Kuala Lumpur.

**Topic:** Killer Snores:- Snoring and Obstructive Sleep Apnea(OSA)

Snoring is often laughed at and taken very lightly. However, it regularly hides a life-threatening disease called OSA(Obstructive Sleep Apnea). OSA sufferers repeatedly choke and gasp for breath accompanied by multiple episodes of breathing stoppages throughout their sleep. These patients invariably end up with high blood pressure and quite a few of them may also end up with heart disease and strokes because of OSA. This will be an interesting and informative talk detailing how to diagnose and treat this condition.

He is practising in Kuala Lumpur with several medical centers as a Consultant ENT Surgeon and Snoring Specialist. 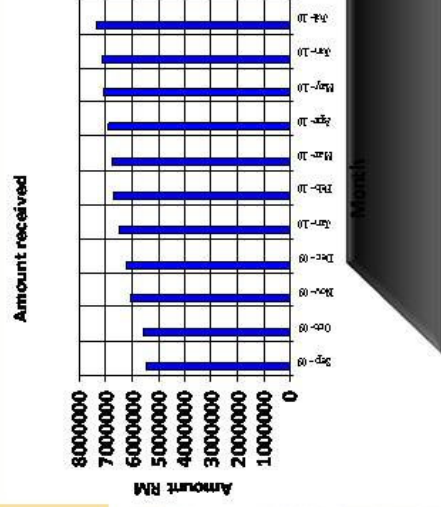
