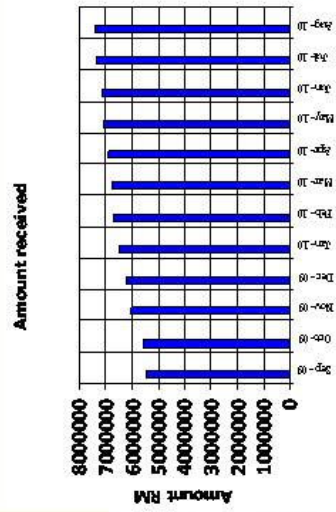
PLEDGES
