#### 4. PARKING AND TRAFFIC CONTROL UPDATES

a) The road in front of the church library is impassable to traffic as a result of the moving of the site hoarding to accommodate piling works and will be closed to traffic until further notice. Church members and parents of Wesley Kindergarten children are to enter through Jalan Wesley (through the MBS main gate) to access the church and exit through Lorong Hang Jebat (Confucian school) on Mondays to Saturdays.

Please note that Jalan Wesley will be opened to vehicles of parents of kindergarten children (please get access pass from kindergarten office) and church members (with church stickers) on Mondays after 8.15 a.m. On Tuesdays to Saturdays Jalan Wesley will be opened after 7.45 a.m.

b) On Sundays, worshippers are to access church services and leave via Jalan Wesley only. Please follow the directions of the traffic wardens. Please do not access church services via Lorong Hang Jebat.

c) Please be reminded that Zone B (opposite church sanctuary entrance) is reserved for physically constrained people (elderly or disabled) and parking space is limited to 10 cars. Parking in Zone B is by registration with the church office. Only registered vehicles with access pass are allowed into Zone B and please display the pass when parking. For those registered for parking in Zone B, do come for service early as we want to maximize the use of parking space in this area.

d) On Saturdays you can park your cars at the school compound but please do not block other cars.

e) At all times, please follow the directions of traffic wardens.

All the above arrangements are implemented with immediate effect.

We regret any inconvenience caused. Your cooperation is most appreciated. Thank you.

#### 7. APPEAL FOR NEW VAN FOR WESLEY HOME

Wesley Outreach Society hopes to replace the current 15-year-old van which is used to transport the residents to medical appointments, church services and other functions, as it breaks down frequently and is beyond economic maintenance. We want to replace it with a Chinese-made van to be fitted with a wheelchair lift. The new van is fitted with a Japanese (Toyota) engine and carries a warranty of 3 years.

Cost of van with wheelchair lift:	RM90,000.00
Less trade-in of present van	: <u>10,000.00</u>
Amount needed for new van	: <u>RM80,000.00</u>

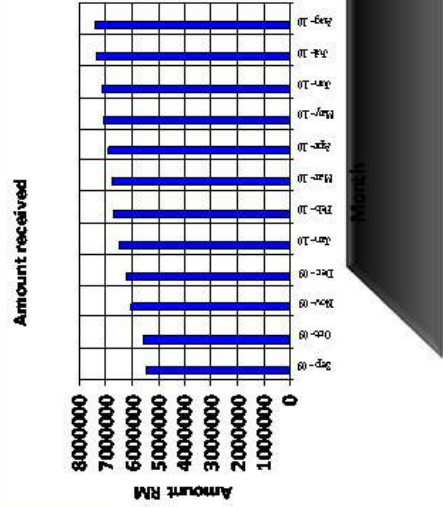

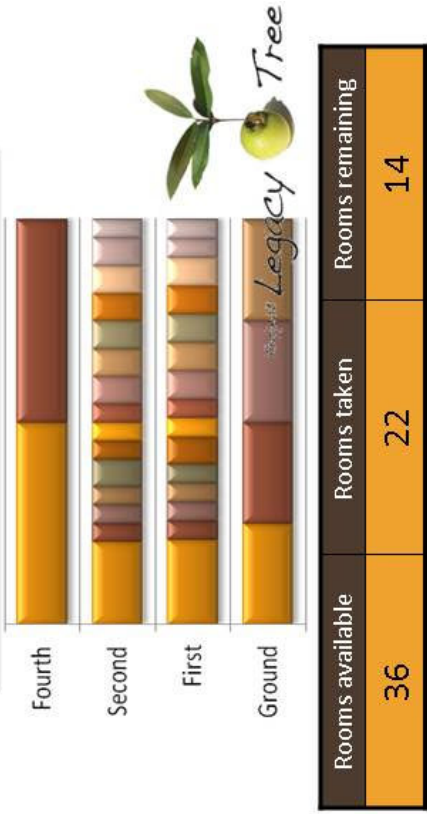
